2. Full paper (by 4/21/2019): (1) Length is limited within 8,000-12,000 words. (2) Format: please refer to the writing format of *the Journal of Applied Chinese* (《應華學報》). More detailed information will be available on the website http://c026.wzu.edu.tw/category/139302. (3) Please submit both a hard-copy and a soft-copy of the full paper. Submit an Word / PDF file to chinese@mail.wzu.edu.tw. The subject line of the submission email should be "submission of the 11th International Conference on Classical and Modern Chinese".

- 1. After the abstract is accepted, whether to submit the full paper is left to the discretion of the author. However, the submitted paper must be published for the first time.
